New Thoroughbred Racing Shoe Regulations

In the last 30 days, news has been released that appears to seriously impact the type of race plates allowed on Thoroughbreds. Effective date was initially July 1, 2022 but this may change. The Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) has received authorization from Congress to put in place numerous rules for the TB racing industry, including one that affects the type of toe inserts allowed on race plates. This is the new rule for horseshoes on Thoroughbred tracks in the US:

"Rule 2276. Horseshoes

- (a) Except for full rims 2 millimeters or less from the ground surface of the Horseshoe, traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb Horseshoes during racing and training on dirt or synthetic racing tracks.
- (b) Traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb Horseshoes during training and racing on the turf.
- (c) Traction devices include, but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar calks and stickers."

As a general rule, all thoroughbred tracks running thoroughbred horse races, other than Nevada, Montana, North Dakota and Idaho, are subject to HISA oversight. The only exception is Nebraska, where only Fonner Park and Columbus are subject to the Act. This information came from the attorney for HISA. It has also been clarified that the rules mean no XT, Low Toe, Regular Toe or Quarter Horse inserts will be allowed for dirt, synthetic or turf. A full rim shoe with an insert that is even with the 2mm rim appears to be acceptable for dirt or synthetic, but not for turf. Our range of rim shoes, primarily used by the Standardbred horses do not meet the 2mm restriction. We are working with Kerckhaert to begin changing production to shoes that will meet the restrictions. Kings with flush toes are permitted and any other shoe – like the Tradition or Legendary – will be allowed if they have a flush toe and Kerckhaert is setting up to produce them.
